UUCUC Guidelines For In Person Meetings, Groups, and Worship
Adopted by Covid Task Force: 12/10/2021
Approved by Board of Trustees: 12/14/2021

We will follow guidelines established by the Champaign-Urbana Public Health Department and Illinois Department of Public Health to ensure our congregation and the community's safety.

- Wear a mask inside at all times. This is UUCUC policy. The only exception applies to persons speaking from the podium who may appear unmasked during this time to facilitate livestreaming.
- 2. Maintain social distancing of 6 feet between households; be mindful of the comfort levels of others.
- 3. Wash your hands. Use hand sanitizer if you are unable to wash your hands.
- 4. We strongly recommend getting vaccinated as well as a booster shot.
- 5. Keep meetings as short as possible to minimize exposure.
- 6. Stay home if you are exhibiting any potential Covid-19 symptoms such as fever, coughing, sneezing, or you have been recently exposed to someone with Covid-19...
- 7. Please keep a record of attendees to assist with contact tracing should the CUPHD notify the church of positive cases among attendees among those present in the building. Send the record to the Director of Congregational Administration, Brian Franklin; or the Director of Facilities, Tim Voelker.
- 8. Currently, food or drinks are not permitted in the building.
