Valborg Aulin (1860-1928) was a professional composer when many women were discouraged from studying music as more than a hobby. Born in Sweden, she studied abroad before returning to compose and perform as a concert pianist.

Amy Beach (1867-1944) was recognized in her own time as one of the first great American composers. She was the first American woman to have a symphony performed.

Michele McLaughlin (b. 1974) is a prolific composer of piano music. She has written and released 18 albums in as many years.
